He said, "India's Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA) could trigger the largest statelessness crisis in the world and cause widespread human suffering". Mr. Shaddan Mohammed Saipillai, Advocate who addressed CAA and NRC from legal perspective, while addressing the students, he said, "The proposed resolution on CAA violation of India's "international obligations" under the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights (ICCPR) and other Human Rights treaties to which New Delhi is a signatory. While the nation-wide protest against the CITIZENSHIP AMENDMENT ACT are happening, most of the young students are confused by the endless array of information and aren't completely sure of what we are really opposing or supporting. Hence after the session, students had a debriefing about the issues. As responsible citizens of the country, many had lots of questions inside their heads and hearts and hence students felt this session as an opportunity to know in about the act.
