Guest Lecture on Role of Family therapists

A guest lecture on Role of Family therapists was organised on 15 November 2022 at 3:30 pm. The lecture was hosted by Mr. Rohit Ramachandran. The event was conducted in the Family counselling classroom, MSSW. The session started with a discussion about the role of a family therapist in family therapy. He also talked about the five therapist traps that the counsellor should be aware in his or her profession and must ensure they don't fall into it.
