The Abstract should mention the Title, Sub-Theme, and details about the author. The author/s of the selected abstract must submit the full paper before **February 15, 2023**.

## Paper Submission Guidelines

**Abstract:** The abstract must be in typed format, not exceeding 300 words, which along with the Registration Form.

## Full Paper Guidelines

1. Papers should have a **basic format** viz: Title, Name of the author(s) Abstract, Key Words (not more than four words).
2. Author's affiliation, Contact address, Designation, Phone/Mobile, and e-mail should be printed as Footnote.
3. **Font Style:** Times New Roman, **Font Size:** 12, **Line Spacing:** 1.5 line Space, **Margin:** 1 inch in the right, left, top and bottom.
4. **Format:** Microsoft Word 2007 or MS Word 2003
5. **Number of Words/Pages:** Within 2000 words/Five Pages including Title, Abstract, Tables and References.
6. References in **APA** style.
7. Plagiarism & copyright violation is strictly denounced

## Poster Presentation

Presenters can also opt for poster presentation based on subthemes. Posters should stimulate discussion, not give a long presentation. Therefore, keep text to a minimum, emphasize graphics, and make sure every item included in your poster is necessary.

### Poster Presentation Guidelines:

1. Utilize handouts to supplement your poster.
2. Goal: 50% text and 50% Images
3. A QR code can also be created so that the poster can be scanned and viewed online by the participants.
4. Display poster should be A3 size.
5. Space will be provided to display the posters.
6. Use charts and graphs to illustrate data (avoid large tables of raw data).
7. Use high resolution photographs.
8. Keep consistent margins and line spacing should also be consistent.
9. Test readability - Title banner should be legible from 20 feet away and body text should be legible from 6 feet away.

### Street Play and Mime Competition (Group)

- Students from Social Work institutions can register and participate in the street play and mime competition.
- One entry per college, **Maximum 8 members** per team, all teams have to enact a street play based on the sub themes of the Conference
- Competition guidelines will be provided to the registered teams
