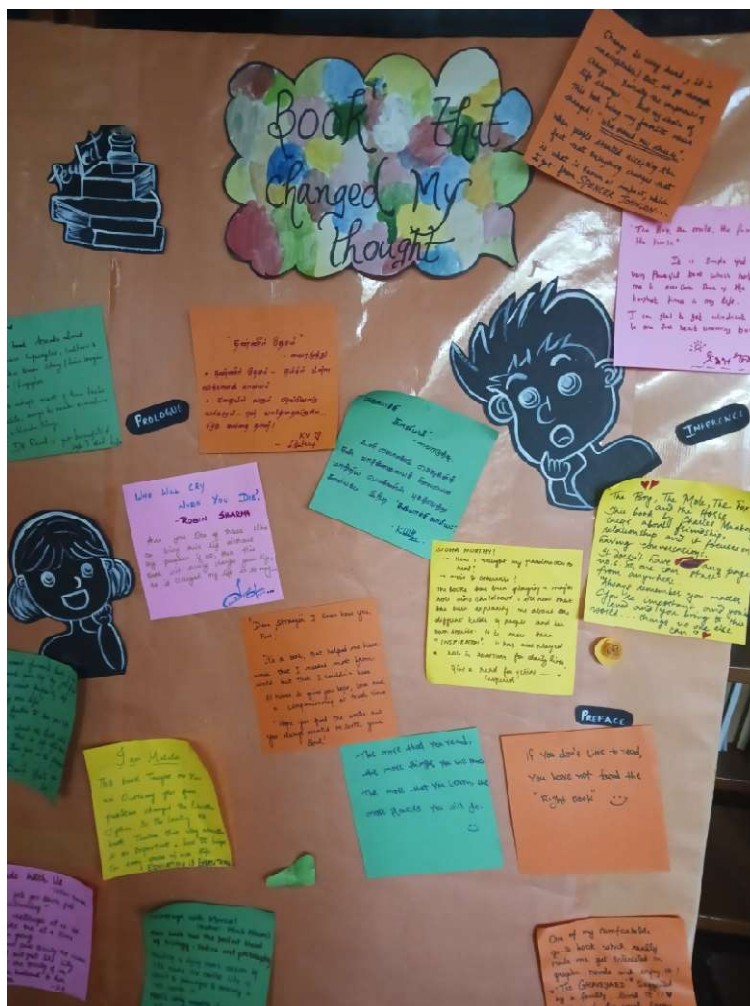

Day 1 : 30th January, 2023 (Monday)

Event 1 – Stick with it (the Book that changed my thought)

Day one was started with a bang on the event 'Stick with it'. Students rushed to the library and wrote about the book that changed their thought by using the stick notes and pinned on the board. 18 students participated in the event. Ms.Devanshi Bali of I BSW was given the best write-up of a book.



Event 2 – Workshop on Reflective Writing

Workshop on 'Reflective Writing' was conducted from 11 am to 01.30 p.m. Ms.Iswarya, Assistant Professor in English, Christu Jayanti College, Bengaluru was the resource person. Ms.Iswarya is an instructional designer, communication trainer, copy editor and recently ventured into literary translation from Tamil to English. She covered the purpose of Reflective Writing, Method of Reflective writing, critical thinking, clarity of expression, benefits of reflective writing and so on. There were 38 students took part in the workshop. Certificate of participation and small refreshment were distributed to the participants at the end. Ms.Tanya of MSW-D&E and Ms.Priyanka of MA-SE

coordinated the workshop. A book was handed over to Ms. Iswarya as a small memento to the resource person.



Event 3 – Inspirational Book

Students were asked to talk about a book that inspired them. Faculty members Mr. Sridhar and Dr. Lakshmi served as judges for the event and selected 2 best speakers - Mr. Amal Jeeva and Ms. Sulagna. Books were given as small mementoes to the judges.

Event 4 – Dumb Charades

It was a team event. Each team consists of 2 students. Book titles of different Genre were given to each team to enact the title. After 3 rounds of performance, one team – Amal Jeeva and Geethanjali won the prize. Mr. Avinash, II MSW (A) coordinated both Inspirational Book and Dumb charades.

Day 2 – 31st January, 2023 (Tuesday)

Event I - Slam Poetry:

Slam Poetry is performance poetry with the combination of writing, performance, competition and so on. Judge of the event Mr. Joel Sebastian gave lots of tips to the participants and made the students to perform. Three students – Supraja, Ananya and Manasa made excellent poems and won the prizes.

Event 2 – Workshop on Poetry Writing

Poetry writing workshop was conducted by Mr. Joel Sebastian who is a cofounder of a thriving poetry community in Chennai called 'Project Prodets'. He has performed numerous poems and judged various cultural events. 24 students participated in the workshop and received the participation certificates including the students of other colleges. A book as memento was given to the resource person. All the participants are served with small refreshment. Ms. Tanya of MSW-D&E and Ms. Priyanka of MA-SE coordinated the workshop.



Day 3 & 4 Events - 01st and 02nd February, 2023 (Wednesday and Thursday)

Event 1 – Unsent Letter to the Author

A letter box was kept ready along with the post-cards. Students were asked to write a letter to their favourite author or author of their favourite book by using the post-cards. Ms.Vaishnavi Reddy of I BSW received the prize.

Day 5 Events – 03rd February 2023 (Friday)

Event 1 – Author’s Talk

Dr.V.Sakthi Rekha, Librarian welcomed the gathering and presented an overview about the Library week. Writer, Author Mr.Agaramudalvan spoke on the topic and his recent book ‘Kadavul, pisasu and Nilam’ in Tamil. He quoted various books and authors for students to read and reflect. He narrated the pain, fear and sorrow the Tamils faced every day in their life in Sri Lanka and how it reflected in his book ‘kadavul, pisasu and nilam’. Dr.S.Raja Samuel, Principal, Madras School of Social Work appreciated the Author with a memento.

Chief guest and Speaker of the Day, Mr.Agara Mudhalvan distributed the prizes to the winners of the competitions held during the week. Ms.Shivasankari, assistant librarian coordinated the event and Ms.Tejaswini, II B.Sc. proposed the vote of thanks. Ms.Mayuri, II BSW coordinated the event with Ms.Tejaswini.





Event 2 – Art & Design Competition (Judge a book by its cover)

Students were asked to design a cover for a book of their choices. Ms.Harini M of II BSc Psychology won the prize for the best design. Ms.Sai Divya, a freelance artist helped us to assess the art and choose the best one. Ms.Tejaswini coordinated the event.

Day 6 Events – 04th February, 2023 (Saturday)

Event – Creative Writing Workshop

Creative workshop was conducted by Ms.Meera Sundarrajan, Writer and author. Ms.Meera is a creative writer and she writes regularly in her blogs. She talked about various genres of writing and the way to write for different genre of books. She discussed about various books, characters, plots and the styles of different authors and so on. 20 students participated in the workshop including the students from other colleges. Sample narration was given to the participants and all the participants were asked to continue to write the stories in their own style and each one's story was discussed at the end.

Participants were distributed with the participation certificates and refreshments. Ms.Sowmya of MA-HRM coordinated the workshop.
