MANAS COMPETITION – 10.10.2022

The PG Department of Psychology, Madras School of Social Work conducted an inter – collegiate and inter – department competition under the title “**MANAS 2022**” on the World Mental Health Day Oct 10th of 2022. The brochure was circulated during the first week of October 2022 and the registrations were collected using Google form. There were three competitions held, art, creative writing and short film. The digital works of Creative writing and short films were submitted by the participants through online and the deadline given was before 5 PM on 9/10/2022. The drawing and painting competition was organized on the mental health day in the premises of PG Department of Psychology.

ART COMPETITION

This was an inter-department competition conducted for the Madras School of Social Work students. Along with the online registrations of the participants, on - spot registration was also undertaken by the members of organizing team. The topic given was “Mental Health Matters”. Participants were provided with chart and informed them priorly to bring their own stationary items. The given time limit was 1 Hour which started from 1 PM – 2 PM. The organizing team under the supervision of Dr. Vyjayanthi Mala, one of the faculty members, PG Department of Psychology keenly facilitated the competition with good hospitality to the participants. The collected artworks were sincerely judged and evaluated by Dr Mohana, Head of Department (HRM), based on the criteria given below.

Criteria

1. Based on the given topic – 20 Points
2. Applying novel or innovative strategy of the content – 20 Points
3. Presentation style – 20 Points
4. Innovative materials used – 20 Points
5. Vulgarly and plagiarism of any sort will be disqualified – 20 Points

CREATIVE WRITING

Registered participants submitted their digital work to the organizing committee through online in PDF format. The topic given was “Mental Health Matters”. This was also an inter-department competition conducted for the students of Madras School of Social Work. The word limit was 1500 – 2000 words in English and Tamil language. The submitted works were judged and evaluated by Prof M S Sivaranjani, Asst Professor of the department of HROD, based on the criteria given below.

Criteria

1. Based on the given topic – 20 Points
2. Applying novel or innovative strategy of the content – 20 Points
3. Presentation style – 20 Points
4. Innovative materials used – 20 Points
5. Vulgarity and plagiarism of any sort will be disqualified – 20 Points

SHORT FILM COMPETITION

This was open to all the UG and PG students of Tamil Nadu Universities and Colleges. The topic given was “Mental Health Matters”. The registered participants were instructed thoroughly about the rules and the time duration of the short film should not exceed 5 minutes (Including beginning and ending credits). Participants were informed to submit their work in MP4 format before the deadline. The short films were screened to the Jury of this Short film competition, Dr R Subhashini, Dean, Madras School of Social Work watched them with immense joy and pleasure by witnessing the talents of upcoming energetic filmmakers. The winners were selected based on the criteria given below.

Criteria

1. Plot and flow of the story – 5 Points
2. Pace and continuity – 5 Points
3. Character development and relevance – 10 Points
4. Originality of the story – 10 Points
5. Level of story engagement – 10 Points

6. Innovative ideas used in story telling – 15 Points
7. Conveyance of the given theme – 10 Points
8. Thought provoking – 10 Points
9. Emotional response provoking – 10 Points
10. Technical quality of the film – 10 Points
11. Creativity involved in the Title – 10 Points
