INTRODUCTION:

On 15th October 2022, Saturday a Guest Lecture on the topic "CSR and the Role Social Worker as Change Agents" was conducted by BSW department Alumnus Mr. Raj Kumar from the batch 2012 to 2015. He is now working for ENDO India, a US based Medical manufacturing company.

PROCEEDINGS:

- The event began at 11:15 AM, Tamil Thai Vaazhthu was sung by the BSW Department students.
- Ms.Hari Priya from BSW 2nd year was the MC for the event.
- The Welcome Address was delivered by Ms. Devanshi Bali, Executive Member.
- Ms. Haripriya gave a brief introduction of Mr. Raj Kumar.
- At 11:20 AM, the session was handed over to Mr.Raj Kumar.
- Mr. Rajkumar began the seminar by asking the students about the meaning of the term "Social Work"
- He then discussed about the various fields that we as social workers can get into.
 Such as Medical and Psychiatry, Community Development, and Human Resource Management.
- He explained the students about the various opportunities they have if they apply for colleges in abroad. He also explained in detail about the process and requirements needed to get into a good institution.
- He emphasized the importance of understanding the Field Work Objectives and Field Work Manual. He also advised that we should have a good relationship with our faculty members and constantly update them about the learnings that we get from our field work, discuss with them and improve your learnings.
- He mentioned that we should always keep track of our reports, get it signed and document it appropriately as these will help in our future.









At 11:50 AM, he explained the term "CSR" that is, Corporate Social Responsibility.
 He told the various reasons as of why CSR was started.

- The major areas that cover CSR are environment, children and women. CSR is a must for all profit making companies. They have to give 2% of their profit of the 3 preceding years to the community as a way of giving back to the society.
- At 12:15 PM, he asked students to go through the Companies act 2013, schedule 7, which had the following policies, Ensuring environmental sustainability, Promoting education, Promoting gender equality, Protection of national heritage, Benefit of armed forces &vehicles. These are some areas in which the companies can work on.
- Social workers play a very vital role in these areas. The social workers, derive an
 action plan for the people of the disadvantaged community. They work as a bridge
 between the people and the company. Get the funds from the company and use it for
 the development of the community.
- If the companies are not having a separate board of members to execute the plan for CSR projects, then the company can give the fund to NGO and keep a track on their functioning.
- He briefly explained how social workers get their salary by working on a CSR project.
- Mr.Raj Kumar then posted a question to the student. "when was the latest amendment for CSR done"?. Mr.Lohith answered this question rightly. It was 20th September 2022. He was given a Thalai Aati Bommai made by Ms. Susi.
- Mr.S.Xavier Vivek Jerry, Forum Coordinator shared a few inputs about the session and handed over the stage to Mr. Albert.
- Mr. Albert spoke about his experience in Rural Camp, he advised us that we should always get our doubts clarified with the faculty members and make use of all the facilities that are available in the college premises.
- At 12:50 PM, the stage was open to the students for questions.









 Ms.Yurekaa asked if Mr. Raj Kumar's company would be willing to give funds to MSSW as CSR projects. He said that we should make a project proposal and then approach the company with a faculty member.

- After the Q&A session the program was concluded and students were asked to fill the feedback forms.
- Mr. Raj Kumar was felicitated by Mr.S.Xavier Vivek Jerry with a book "The Alchemist" written by Paulo Coelho.
- The event ended with the National Anthem
- At 1:30 PM, Ice cream was served as refreshment.

CONCLUSION

The event was insightful for the students to gain information. Each student was now aware of the CSR, its functioning and the Role of Social Workers in this area.
