Interview Instructions

- 1. Follow the College website for the admission schedule and updates.
- 2. Candidates are shortlisted for an interview based on their self-declared marks and performance in the entrance examination.
- 3. The personal interview will be conducted offline at the college according to the schedule.
- 4. Arrive 15 minutes before the scheduled interview time and bring the following documents:
 - o Application Form signed by the candidate and parents/guardian
 - Self-attested copies of the following documents:
 - SSLC/10th Mark Sheet
 - HSC/12th and 11th/+1 Mark Sheet
 - UG Semester/Consolidated Mark Statements (Semester/Non-Semester)
 - Provisional Degree Certificate
 - NSS/NCC/YRC/RRC/Sports certificates
 - Transfer Certificate (if available)
 - Certificates supporting claims for Government provisions (e.g., Community Certificate, Child of Ex-service men certificate, Disability certificate, etc.)
- 5. During the interview, the Department will verify self-declared details and calculate percentages accordingly. For candidates awaiting results, the percentage will be based on 5th/7th-semester marks. For completed courses, all semester marks will be considered.
- 6. If you need to reschedule the interview, submit a letter or email to the HOD with valid reasons to obtain permission.
