
The diploma course is designed for people in a multidisciplinary (including clinical, social, environmental disciplines) range of professions. The multidisciplinary nature of participants encourages exchange of ideas and research frameworks between participants.

The whole course consists of three parts.

- The first part (part I) concerns the preparatory reading prior to the start of the lecture/workshop series.
- The second part (part II) includes masterclasses and workshops covering 6 themes spread out over 6 days.
- Finally, part III involves translating learnings into the student's own research or work, via an individual portfolio assignment.
