**REPORT OF THE MEETING HELD ON 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2024**

The PTA meeting and election was conducted on 20<sup>th</sup> of July, 2024. The meeting was planned and executed under the guidance of PTA Coordinator Dr.Kalyani Kenneth along with all the PTA faculty representatives from different departments. Approximately 90 parent representatives from various departments, Principal in-charge, Dean, PTA faculty representatives, Heads of the departments and faculty members attended the meeting.

The general body meeting started off with the Tamil Thai Vazhthu followed by the College song sung by students. Dr. Mohana (Associate Professor, MA HRM) delivered the welcome address, extending a warm welcome to the Dean, Principal in Charge, parents, teachers, and previous office bearers. Dr. Mohana highlighted the importance of the PTA in fostering a collaborative environment between parents and the school administration.
