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PRINCIPAL' S REPORT

The Academic Year 2022 – 23 was significant to us as we had a full academic year after COVID and we bounced back with greater vigour to initiate and complete a wide variety of activities. We are also in our Platinum Jubilee year after completing 70 glorious years. Our ranking among our peers continue to be high with 38th in NIRF ranking among all colleges in India and within the top 5 Colleges for Social Work in India. We will march forward and improve our ranking in the coming years.

ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR

- We had the full complement of **868** students of whom **64%** were women students in the 10 programs affiliated to University of Madras. We received more than **4000** applications for the 395 seats at a ratio of 1:10. We have admitted students from **16** states of our nation which has truly enhanced the diversity in the campus.
- This year we launched a new PG program – MSc Family Counselling, a Diploma Program in Industrial Relations in partnership with Kelsa and a Diploma Program in Community Mental Health in partnership with Banyan.
- This year **two** International conferences, **three** National conferences were conducted on a variety of themes. Apart from these **21** certificates courses and **26** workshops have been conducted for the benefit of our students. Over **219** guest speakers and resource persons have participated in these events.
- Our placement record this year has been spectacular with over **103** students placed with an average CTC of **5.7** lakhs per annum. Over **55** organizations have visited us for placements.

STUDENT ACHIEVEMENTS

This year we are glad to announce that **11** students have cleared NET exams with **2** students – Nivetha, MSW and Sangeetha Bisht, Psychology winning JRF.

Apart from academics, our students have been active in co-curricular activities throughout the year. Over **491** students have participated in seminars / events outside college and **58** students have participated in competitions outside college. Students have won over **38** prizes.

FACULTY ACHIEVEMENTS

We have excellent teaching staff who are the backbone of the achievements of the college. Apart from their teaching responsibilities, faculty have presented 52 papers in conferences and have published 33 papers in journals. Dr Jackson Khumukcham, MASE program was awarded PhD Degree by Tata Institute of Social Sciences and Dr Sudarmathy, BSW Program by University of Madras. Dr Lakshmi Dr Chandrasekar Dr Thirumagal, and of SW Dept received approval for guiding PhD scholars. Nine PhD scholars received their PhD Degrees this year. Three of our faculty members Dr Chandrasekar, Dr. Sudarmathy and Dr Mohana have obtained patents for their work.

RESEARCH / CONSULTANCY

Apart from our academic and co-curricular activities, I am delighted to present some of our significant achievements and recognitions in the collaborations, research and consultancy areas which have been carried out by our faculty members.

- Our collaboration with the Government of Tamil Nadu has reached a new level with the recent announcement in the Assembly regarding setting up a Centre for Social Justice and Equity at MSSW supported by the Dept of Adidravidar and Tribal Welfare Dept with an annual grant of Rs. 2 crores.
- We have been asked by the Labour Department to serve as a Consultant for conducting a State-wide survey on Migrant labour.
- The EDII, Govt of Tamil Nadu has recognized MSSW as a Hub for Social Entrepreneurship and has given funding to train 60 Social Work departments in colleges the state on social entrepreneurship.

- MSSW evaluated two major Govt schemes and gave a report:
 - Free saree dhoti scheme involving feedback from 6000 beneficiaries
 - Amma Unavagam involving feedback from 2, 11, 555 users
- We provided need based skill training through more than 50 empanelled trainers to over 13, 230 women SHG members in 16 districts of Tamil Nadu under the Tamil Nadu Rural Livelihoods Mission.
- We presented a report on issues in correctional administration and remedies for children in conflict with law to the Department of Social Defense, Government of Tamil Nadu. For the same department we conducted another study on the effective implementation of foster care in Tamil Nadu.
- We submitted a report to ICMR on Psycho-social Wellbeing of lost to follow-up TB Patients.
- Supported by UNHCR, we presented a report on Vulnerability of Srilankan young girls and women refugees in the rehabilitation camps of Tamil Nadu to the Commissioner of Rehabilitation and Welfare of Non-Resident Tamils.
- One of our faculty members developed a training module on Friendly Public Relations for Police personnel of Tamil Nadu to be implemented through Anna Administrative Staff College to over 1.5 lakh police personnel.
- One of our faculty members implemented social audit of a housing project of Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board.
- Our Consultancy division assessed community needs and social impact for NTECL, Vallur Plant.
- We also assessed the social impact of CSR activities of the Kudamkulam

A significant intervention launched this year is the Chennai Collective for Homeless with the support of Azim Premji Philanthropy, through which we are reaching out to over 3000+ homeless persons in Chennai to improve quality of shelters and assist them in obtaining various entitlements. Our thanks to Dr Sakthi Rekha, Mr. Antony Stephen, Dr Gajendran and Mr. Ramkumar who are part of this initiative.

Our expertise has made a mark as indicated by the various assignments we carried out not only for the Government, but also for NGOs and Corporate organizations.

- Living wage survey of Jasmine Pickers for Sythile.

Our rural community development work at Karalappakkam village achieved a milestone with the training with NSDC certification provided to 20 women as sewing machine operators, most of whom are now self-employed.

We set up two food kiosks in our campus to provide livelihood for transpersons apart from a kiosk for a woman social entrepreneur with disability to sell nature friendly products. We helped 25 transpersons to obtain micro loans from Equitas and Ajaya Foundation.

In collaboration with TNSDC and Aavin we trained 30 persons with disabilities to work in Aavin parlours. More batches are in the pipeline.

The MSW Dept assists Guild of Service in managing their Adolescent Girls Study Centre at Mangalapuram.

We appreciate the role played by Dr R Subashini, Dr Sarah Karunakaran, Dr Enoch and Mr Daniel in managing these extension activities and particularly to Ms. Jaishree Chater for networking with various organizations for scholarships, projects and MoUs.

Decision making for holistic development - A framework for leaders in educational context

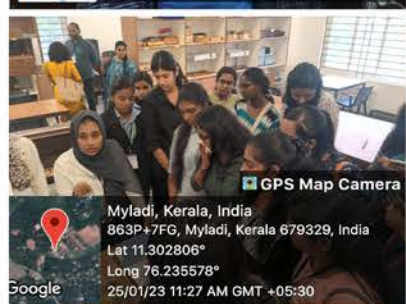

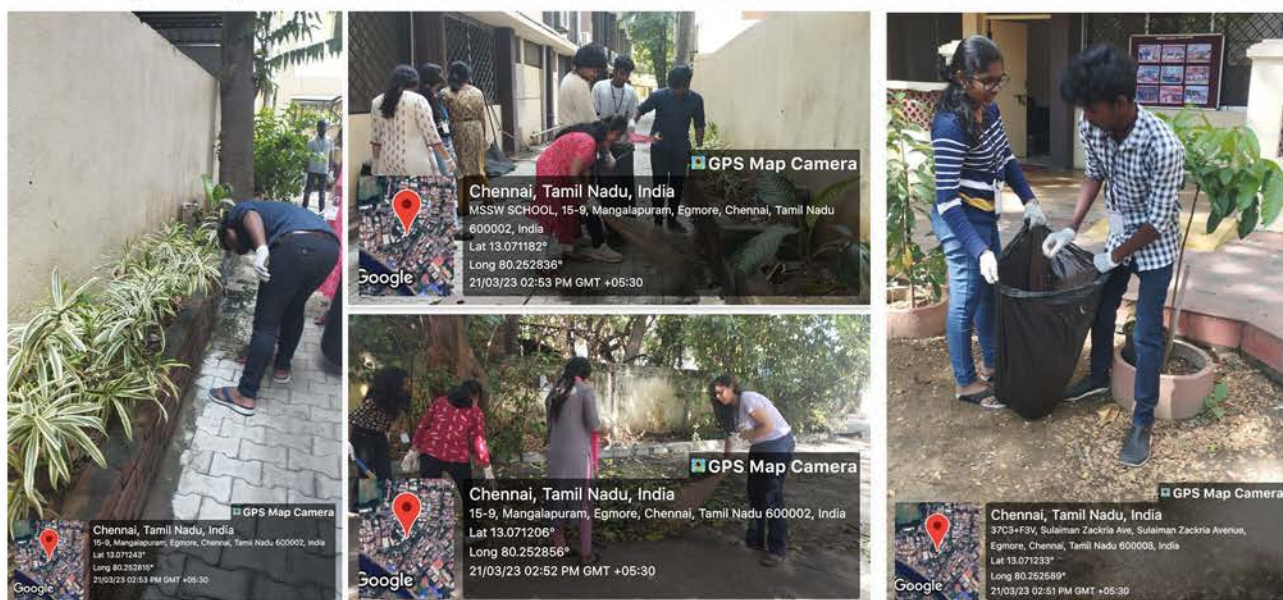
Anti-Narcotics Club:

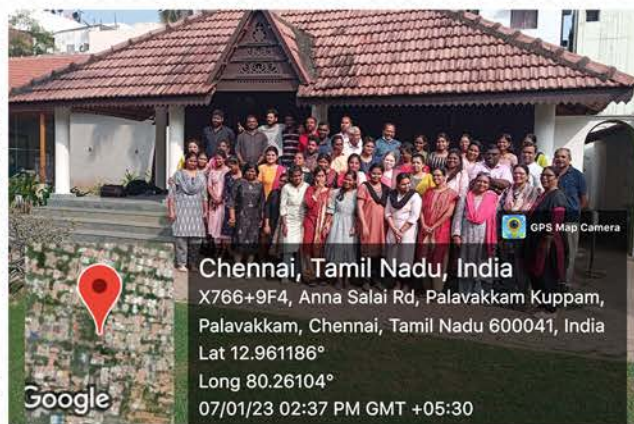


Staff Welfare Association:

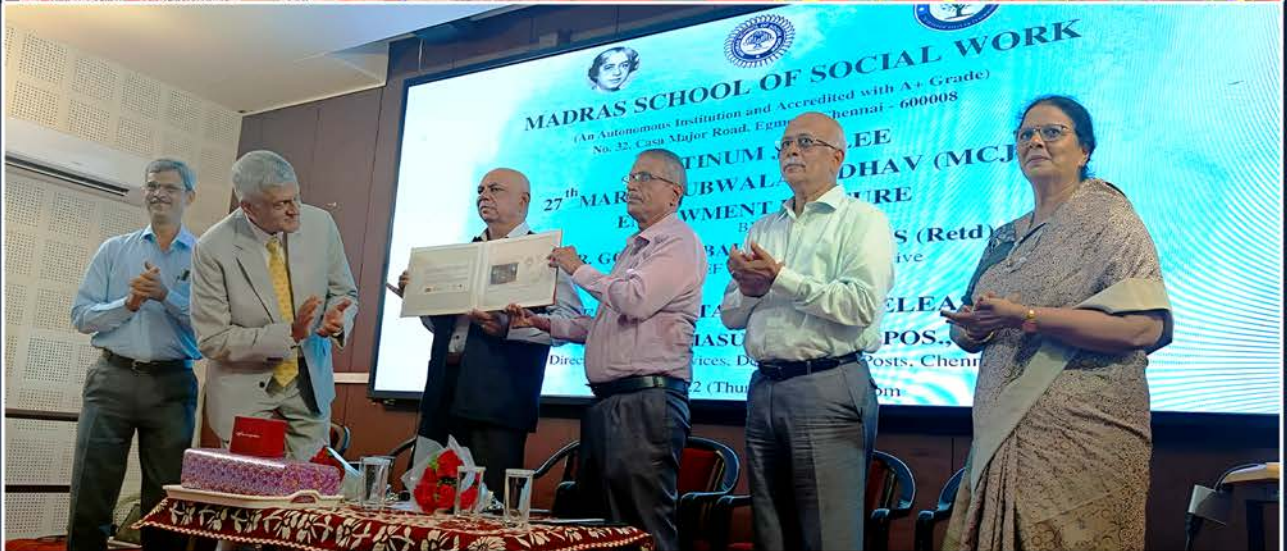
