CODE OF CONDUCT

All the candidates are expected to adhere to the spirit of the college and the true democratic traditions of consultation and participation showing priority to values such as social and ethical responsibilities, mutual trust and respect.

**CAMPAIGNING FOR ELECTION OF PRESIDENT, ACADEMIC SECRETARY,
CAMPUS SECRETARY, OUTREACH SECRETARY, CULTURAL SECRETARY,
SPORTS SECRETARY, MEDIA AND COMMUNICATION SECRETARY**

CANDIDATES ARE ALLOWED TO DO THE FOLLOWING:

1. Person to Person campaign during the allotted time.
2. Addressing the students and explaining the manifesto during the allotted time and place.
3. All students including the candidates should produce their college identity cards on demand by authorities.
4. The students will be permitted to vote only on producing original College identity card.

CANDIDATES ARE NOT ALLOWED TO DO THE FOLLOWING:

1. The Election Commission will not allow political interference, money power, unwarranted noise, and pompous show of affluence, entry of outsiders, wild campaigning, unruly shouts, hoarse cries and campaigning based on Gender, religion, caste or community.
2. No vehicles and no animals should be used for campaigning.
3. No banners and processions are permitted.
4. Printing and exhibition of Handbills is totally prohibited.
5. Beating of drums or playing the musical instruments, use of microphones, loud speakers, megaphones, etc. are prohibited.
6. Candidates are forbidden to involve any outsider in the election process at any time.

7. Giving compliments or gifts in any form is strictly prohibited.
8. Exhibition of posters, distribution of handbills, writing on roads or walls or campaigning in buses and in trains and any such campaigning outside the campus is strictly forbidden.
9. No candidate is allowed to enter any class during class hours to campaign in any manner.
10. Garlanding, bursting of crackers and display of flex banners even after the declaration of results is totally banned inside and outside the campus.

If candidates are found indulging in any of these acts, it will lead to cancellation of their candidature and also cancellation of elections if required.
